- Submit two letters of recommendation. **ONE LETTER MUST BE FROM A SCHOOL BASED PERSON**
- Submit an official high school transcript
- Be accepted by and enrolled full-time in an accredited four-year institution of higher learning for the fall semester of the current school year. Official confirmation from the institution that you have actually enrolled for the fall term will be necessary before funds are paid to the institution
- An essay 750-1,000 words on one of the following subjects: **How can I help change the “quality of life” within my neighborhood by obtaining a college education and pursuing a career in Public Service (government), Economic Development (business/housing), Community Empowerment (organizing/advocacy) or Neighborhood Revitalization (community and real estate development)?**

Note: Preference will be given to students residing in Wards 5, 6, and 7.
