- Submit an official high school transcript
- Acceptance by and enrolled full-time in an accredited two- or four-year institution of higher learning for the Fall semester of 2022. Official confirmation from the institution that you have actually enrolled for the fall term will be necessary before funds are paid to the institution.
- A 500-650-word essay on the following subject: *How can I help change the “quality of life” within my neighborhood by obtaining a college education and pursuing a career in Public Service (government), Economic Development (business/housing), Community Empowerment (organizing/advocacy) OR Neighborhood Revitalization (community and real estate development)?*
